<p>Description of Program and Placement Opportunity:</p> <p>The Seniors and Caregivers Support Service Unit at Family Service Toronto provides social work services to older people and caregivers. Our work includes counselling, group work, advocacy, training and educational sessions on a variety of topics such as aging and memory loss, anger and guilt, how to access community resources, abuse of older adults, etc.</p> <p>Services offered to seniors and those over 50 with a disability both in office and via home visits.</p> <p>Work also entails counseling and support around a variety of issues from bereavement to anxiety, depression and loss. Students are offered a wide variety of experiences including direct counseling experience with both senior and caregiver populations using a variety of modalities and therapeutic interventions.
